



# FEMININE HYGIENE GRANT 2025-2026

## Goal:

To provide feminine hygiene products for female students in need in an effort to prevent absences and other hardship

## Allowable:

- Pads
- Tampons
- Pantyliners
- Disposable wipes
- Female underwear
- Dispensers (restrictions apply\*)

## Not allowable:

- Soap
- Shampoo
- Deodorant
- Pain relieving medication
- Male underwear
- Clothing (leggings)
- Heating pads (electric and disposable)

## Grant eligibility and dispersal:

Each district will receive funds based on the October 2024 FTE report of female students in grades 5-12. These funds are intended for female students who need the products for school and home use; the end use date is 6/30/26.

## Purchasing suggestions:

- Buy bulk in order to get the most affordable products.
- Partner with food banks, hospitals, and healthcare systems.

## Distribution models:

- Place in restrooms with a sign designating who to notify when product is low.
- Distribute from the nurse or counselor's office.
- Distribute from classrooms of participating teachers.
- Provide bulk supplies for home use by packaging in concealing bags or boxes.

\*Dispensers purchased with funds MAY NOT be any type that requires payment to receive products. Additional recommendations are provided on the Dispenser Recommendation flyer.
